

HISTORY OF THE PORT OF CADDO-BOSSIER




PORT OF CADDO-BOSSIER HISTORY

- 1830's Capt. Henry Miller Shreve oversaw the removal of the "Great Raft"
- Debris blocking navigation on the Red River was removed




PORT OF CADDO-BOSSIER HISTORY

- 1962 Port of Caddo-Bossier formed
- 1995 First load of cargo arrives at Port



PORTS OF LOUISIANA

- The Port of Caddo-Bossier is one of 32 ports across Louisiana
- It is also located at the head of navigation of the Red River Waterway




PORT OF CADDO-BOSSIER

Currently located on 4,000 acres in Caddo and Bossier parishes

TENANTS

- Home to 17 national and international companies
- The companies handle everything from steel coils, to petroleum products to packaging
- These companies employ more than 1,700 workers
- Studies show that for every job created at the Port another 4 jobs are created in Caddo and Bossier Parishes

CADDO-BOSSIER PARISHES PORT COMMISSIONERS


- Governed by the 9 member Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission
- Members represent City of Shreveport, City of Bossier City, Bossier City Police Jury and Caddo Parish commission.
- They are selected by the governing bodies to serve on the board.





















WHAT'S NEW?



TERNIUM

- \$98 million investment in its plant at the Port of Caddo-Bossier
- Adding 2nd coil coating line
- Creates 35 new jobs / average salary: \$69,000 / 98 indirect jobs






SUNNY POINT AGGREGATES

- Joint Partnership with Performance Proppants and the Port for wet sand facility
- Dredging river sand from Red River for natural gas fracking sites
- 60-90 new jobs, salaries of \$55-85K/yr, \$25-\$36M processing facility
- 40 acres at Port of Caddo-Bossier
- Operations should begin later this year



NEW WAREHOUSE

- \$14 million, 100,000 sq. ft. heavy industrial (coils and other items) project
- Rented by current Port tenant Odyssey Logistics to store steel cables for another Port tenant
- Built by the Port



BIA ENERGY

- Port sponsored \$650M in bonds
- \$1 billion methanol production plan
- Creates 75 jobs/avg. salary \$80,000/390 indirect jobs
- Incorporate natural gas from Haynesville Shale
- Eco-friendly Reduces CO2 emissions by 90%



TEAL JONES GROUP

- \$110.5M sawmill in Plain Dealing
- 235 acres in Plain Dealing
- 369 indirect jobs avg. salary \$47K + benefits
- Port sponsored \$55M in bonds





ALL ROADS LEAD TO THE PORT

- Access to 3 interstates (I-20 / I-49 / I-30)
- I-69 Service Road
- Feasibility/environmental study underway on service road
- 10.5 miles long (7 miles in DeSoto, 3.5 miles in Caddo)
- \$45.5M project (applying for RAISE grants to cover increase)
- Connecting Port to I-49
