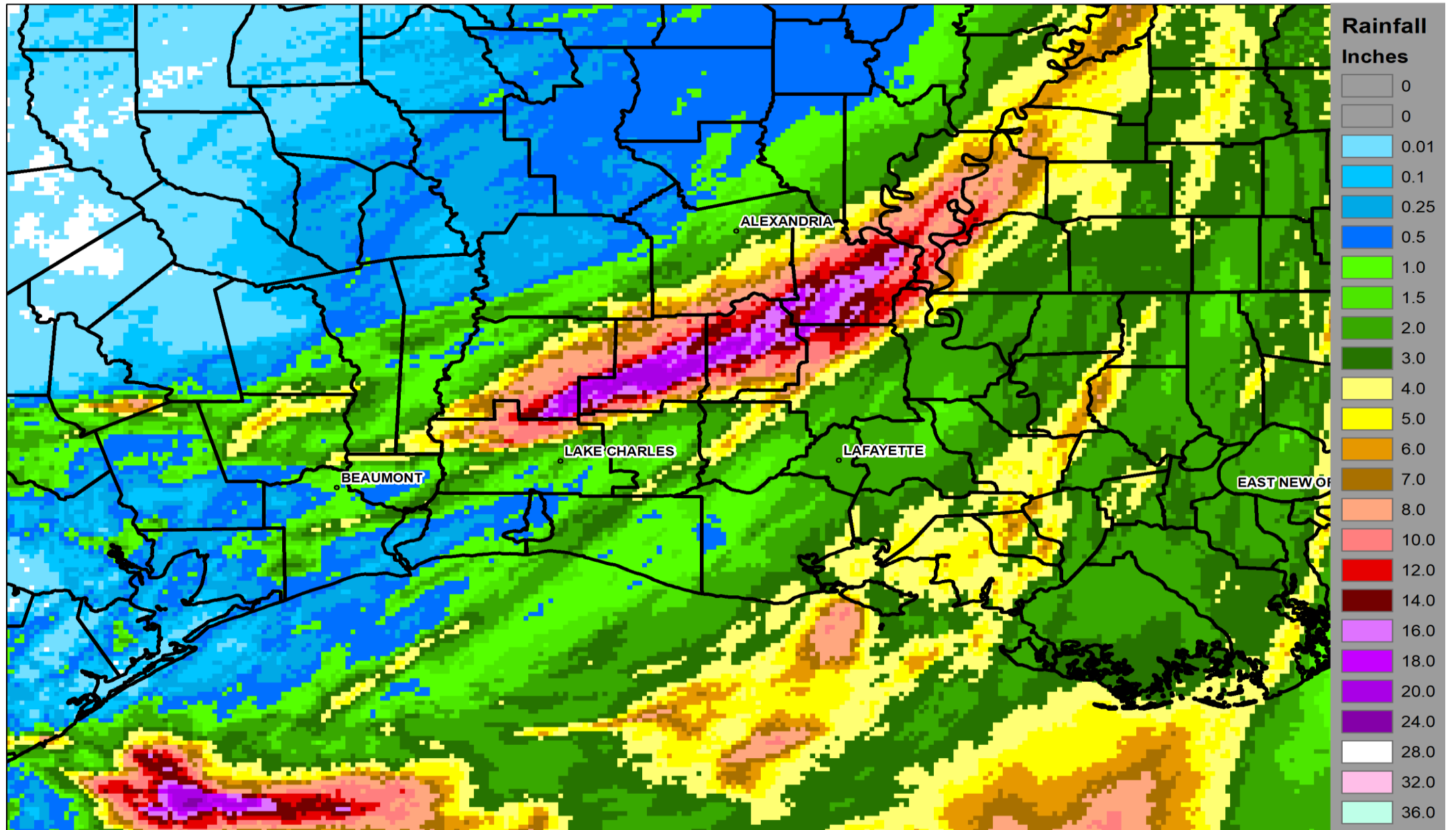

III. Criteria

- A large number of residents in the affected area did not/could not evacuate & they remain in the affected area after the event
- The affected area has sustained a large amount of power outages & will not have power restored for at least a few days from the date of the POD request by the Parish
- There are no open retail grocery stores that sell life sustaining commodities within the affected area, or the road network is compromised to such an extent that the affected population cannot travel to open retail grocery stores



DEPENDING ON TYPE OF DISTRIBUTION NEEDED

STATE OF LOUISIANA LOGISTICS

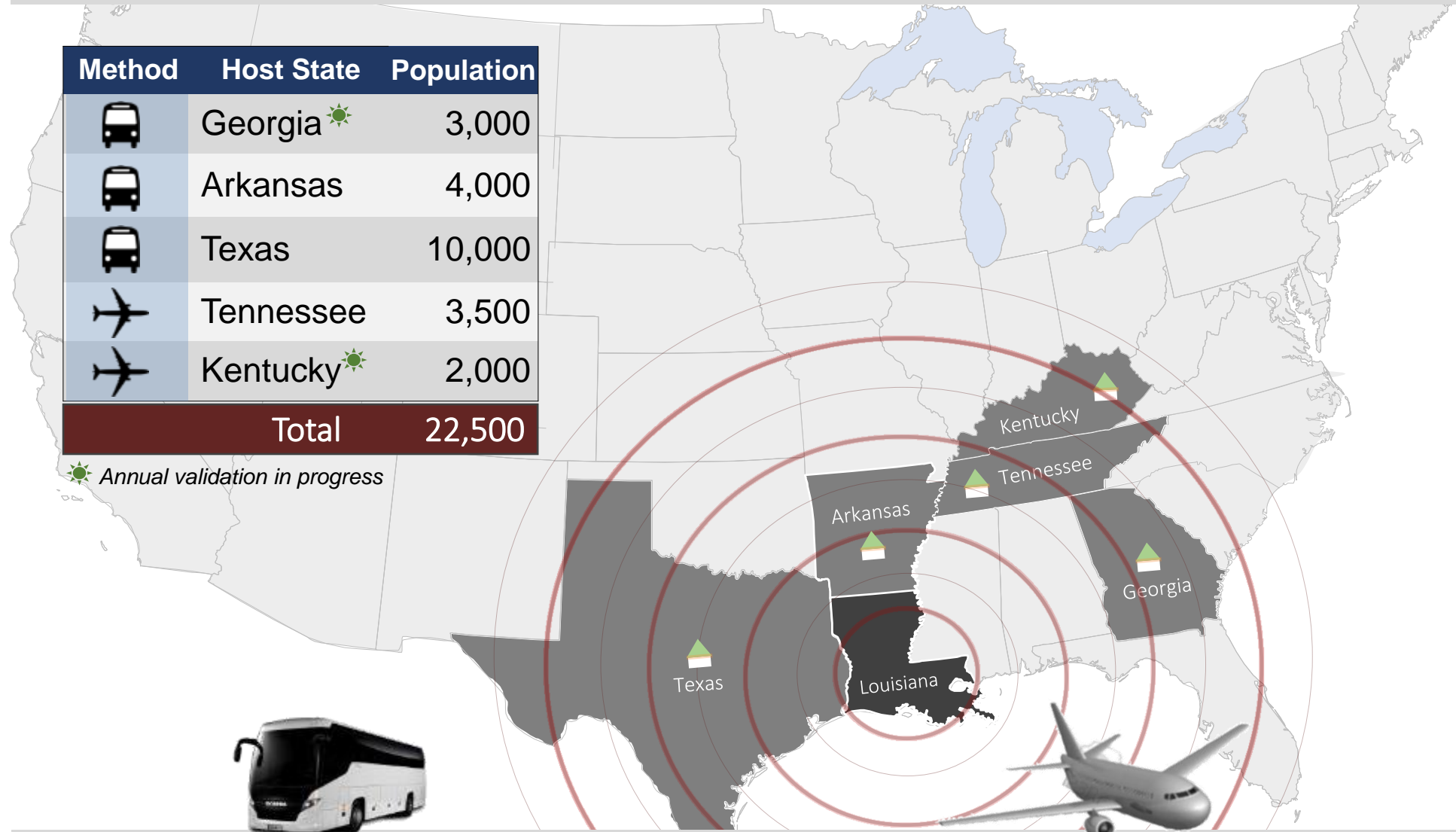
- ST MARY OHSEP MAKES RESOURCE REQUEST TO STATE AND THE ORDER FILLED FROM VARIOUS LOCATIONS
